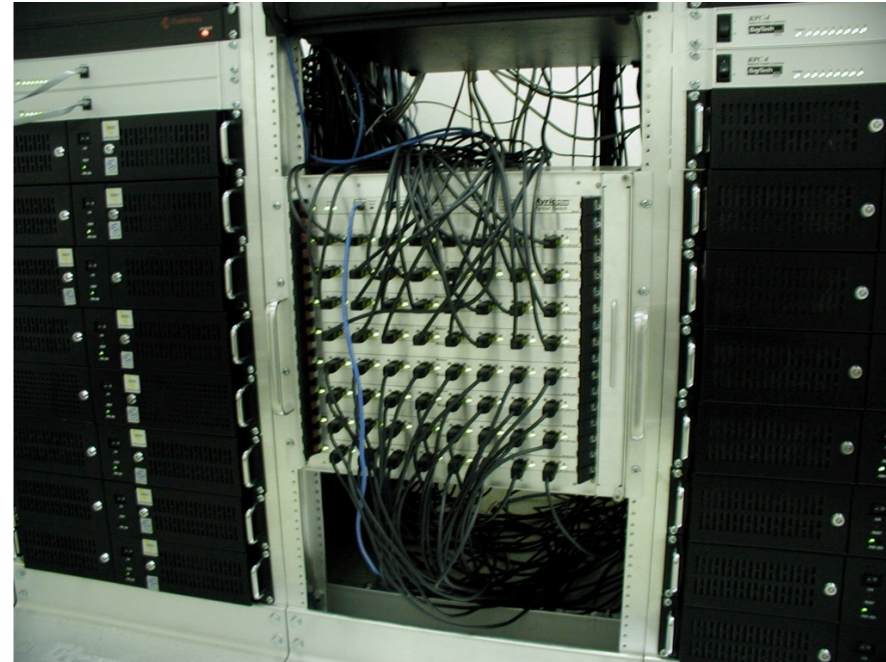

The Keck Cluster



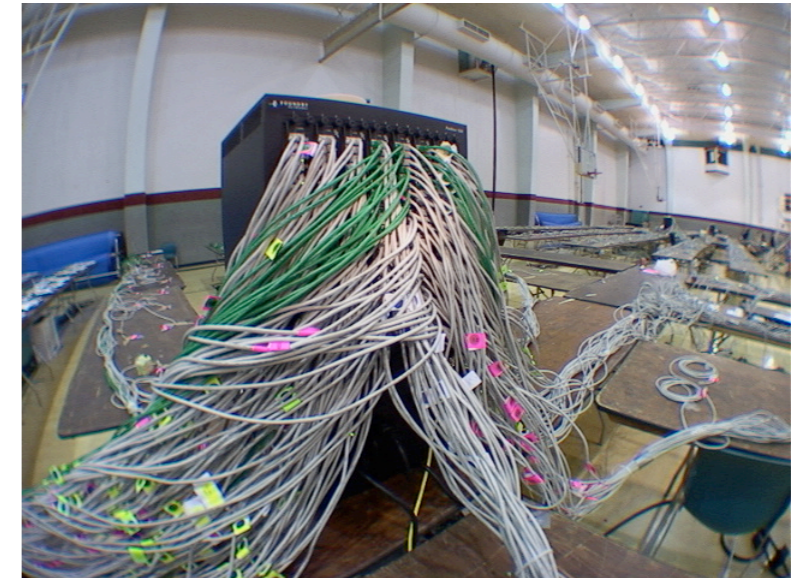
- Built in 2001
